

Product dosing guide for combination therapy with NICODERM® and NICORETTE®

Pick Your Starting Patch Based On Your Cigarette Usage

One cigarette delivers 1-2 mg of nicotine

MAXIMUM DOSES: Patients should not exceed 1 patch daily, 2 sprays at a time/4 sprays per hour/64 sprays per day, 20 pieces of gum, 15 lozenges or 12 cartridges per day. See product inserts for more information.

Titrating combination therapy

- · Use starting NRT patch dose for 6 weeks and reduce dose by 7 mg every 2 weeks thereafter
- If strong cravings return when attempting downward titration, consider remaining at the higher dose for longer
- NRT can be used for 10-12 weeks or longer, if necessary

Gum, lozenge, inhaler or spray can be used after discontinuation of patch, as required.
